The Conference

MYAN Australia in partnership with the Graduate School of Education at the University of Melbourne will be hosting its national conference - *Young people in a multicultural world: rethinking a new policy and practice agenda* - on 23rd and 24th November at the University of Melbourne.

The conference is the first of its kind to be held in Australia. It will consider the experiences of young people from refugee and migrant backgrounds in the context of current global challenges and explore how research, policy and practice can address these challenges into the future. Across the 2 days we will be exploring the themes 'Global Citizenship', 'Education to Work' and 'Social Cohesion'. We will be exploring what is needed to ensure that young people from refugee and migrant backgrounds thrive in Australia in the coming decades.
